- **Conduct a needs assessment of our shelter;** plan and implement a drive to collect specific needed items to donate.
 - Contact Katie Boyden at 603.889.2275 ext 36 or at Katie@hsfn.org and ask about the shelter's needs. From there create a collections bin and ask for donations of items to help the pets awaiting adoption.
- **Collect cardboard litter boxes for our cats** – Using Cardboard Soda flats as litter boxes is the cleanest/most sanitary way for our staff to care for our cats. Reach out to your local grocery store, restaurant etc. and ask them to save their cardboard soda flats. Go by participating stores and restaurants and collect these for our cats awaiting adoption. This is a HUGE help!
- **Make Curtailments for our cats** – Curtailments allow our cats privacy, while creating a more appealing environment in our cat room | [LINK](#)

- **Make Snuffle Mats For both dogs and cats** –Snuffle mats are great for animal enrichment. We use them to hide treats and provide physical and mental stimulation for our animals | [LINK](#)
- **Make Items** – Become an Animal-Entrepreneur! Make buttons, magnets, artwork, scarves etc. Make items that you can sell and donate the proceeds to help animals in need.
