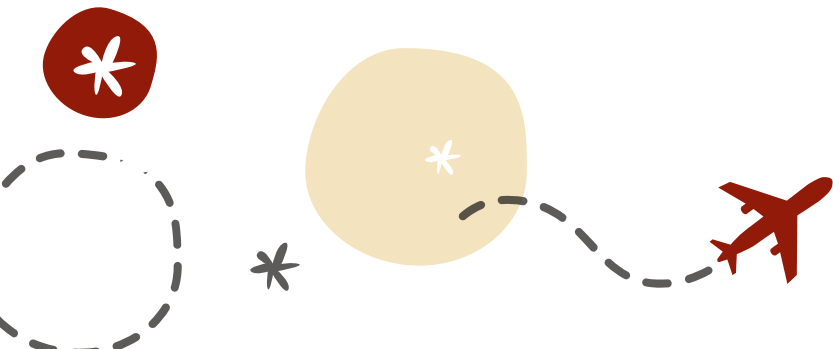


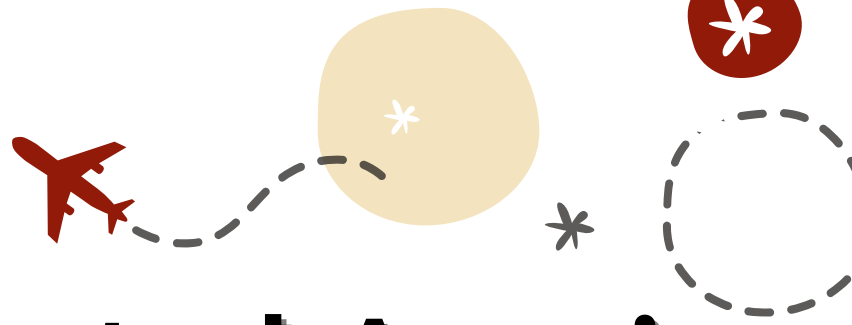

Because they work high in the mountains, they have a long, fluffy coat to keep them warm.





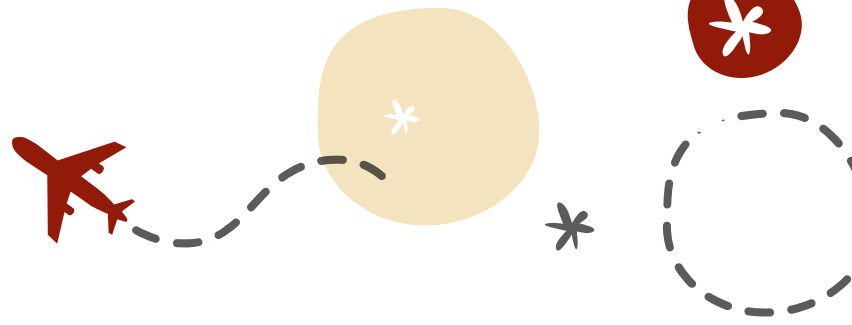
